

Families, use this to prompt conversations at the table, in the car, and anywhere else your family experiences life together.

- Think about a time when a family member or close friend was away. How did it feel to wait for them to return? What was it like when they came home?
- How do you think that experience is like waiting for Jesus to return?
 How is it different?
- What is something (or someone) you are waiting for right now?



It's-Not-Over Mosaic

Jesus promised His friends that one day He would come back and take them to be with Him! For friends of Jesus, death is not the end. We live with the hope of eternity with our Savior! As a family, explore the idea that no matter how bad things look, the story is not over because Jesus will return!

Give your child a red or green sheet of paper and have her tear it into small pieces. When she's done, say: Wow! It looks like things are over for that poor piece of paper! Do you think there's any hope left for it? Talk and laugh together about her answer. Then, help her create something beautiful from the scraps. If using red paper, arrange the scraps into the shape of a heart. If using green, form an evergreen tree from the scraps. Together, glue the scraps onto white paper. Your child can add details to her mosaic with crayons or markers.

For older kids, add challenge by giving them multiple colors of paper and inviting them to create any picture they would like.





As friends of Jesus, we live with the sure hope that Jesus will return! Take a walk as a family. (Or, if it's too cold outside, look out the window.) Name all the things that look dead but that you know will be filled again with life in the spring, such as grass, deciduous trees, or bird nests. Each time a family member spots one, stop and say this prayer together: Jesus, thank You that this (name of item) will be filled with life again!

After the walk, use the bolded words as you talk together about what you saw: A lot of things look lifeless in the winter, but we know they'll be filled with life again in the spring! Life with Jesus is like that. Even when we feel sad and discouraged, we can live with hope because we know Jesus will return, and He is preparing a place in heaven for us!
