Pair up family members and have partners face one another. Pick one partner in each pair to be the “mirror” and then explain: **The partner who's not the mirror will make funny faces and movements, and the mirror will reflect back by doing those actions too. Mirrors don't talk, so try to do everything silently—except for laughing!**

After about 90 seconds, partners can switch places. See who can make the weirdest faces and do the wackiest dance moves. For extra fun, switch partners and play again.

After the activity, enjoy a snack together and talk about what might happen if you all tried to reflect the love God has shown you to others. What could you do or say? And how might that change things in your home, at school, or at a job?

Pause to pray together too, asking God through His Holy Spirit to help you see ways you can reflect God's love to others—including each other—in the coming days.
