Have a fun parade in your home or backyard! Start with an adult and lead your family around single file while doing your best marching or dance moves. Whatever the leader does, everyone else must do—or at least attempt. To make it extra fun, add things like a chicken dance or crab walk, or pick up random props as you go. Give each person a chance to lead.

Discuss the difference between leading and following. Ask: **How does God lead us? Do you think it's hard to follow God? Why or why not? How can you follow God this week?**

Why all-pro? Because you'll try to fool the people who know you best—your family!

In this activity, you'll share three statements about your life. Two will be true, but one will be false—a trick. Everyone in your family will attempt to determine which of the statements is false. Some topics could include something that happened at school or the store, your favorite sports team, your favorite dessert, or what's worrying you. The upside of this game is that you'll get to know more about your family members!

When you're finished, discuss the game together: **What's something new you learned about a family member? Which trick was the hardest to detect? Which trick was the easiest?**

Even though we're family, there's always something new to learn about each other's feelings and experiences. It's different with God though. He already knows everything about you. Not only does He know you, but He loves and leads you too.
