FAMILY CONVERSATIONS

Families, use this to prompt conversations at the table, in the car, and anywhere else your family experiences life together.

WALK IT ACT IT MOVE IT

Tower of Babel Talent Show

Get together and have a family talent show. Invite each family member to do something unique, such as sing a song, draw a picture, or dribble a basketball. When each person's performance is through, instead of clapping or applauding the person, remind her that God created her for a purpose by saying, **"Wow! God sure did have a good plan when He created you."** Remind each other that God's plan is enough, and we don't need to do things our way, so others think we are important. Instead, God invites us to be part of His plan. God is the best, and His plan is enough!



BIBLE MEMORY

Stacking the Word of Wonder

Use cardboard boxes, toy blocks, or even canned goods to have a family tower-stacking Bible memory relay! On each box, block, or canned good, write one word or the reference from the Word of Wonder: 2 Timothy 2:13. (Note that if you'll need 16 stacking items if using the NIV and 13 for the NIV.)

Place the prepared stacking items at one end of the hall or yard and designate a building area at the other end. On your signal, each family member will take turns finding the item with the next word in the verse on it and placing it in the building area. Continue until all blocks have been used and the Word of Wonder tower is complete. If your family includes multiple kids and adults, prepare materials for two towers and have a kids versus adults Word of Wonder stacking race!

Say the verse together. Then review the Tower of Babel story and remind kids that even when we are not faithful to God and try doing things in our own power, He is faithful to us and His plan is always enough!
